Driving Directions to Smith College

From the South: Northampton is on Route I-91 in Massachusetts. Take Exit 18, and follow Route 5 north into the center of town. Turn left onto Route 9. Go straight through four traffic lights, turning left into Smith's main entrance (College Lane) shortly after the fourth set. The Science Center, Bass#5, Burton #6, McConnell#15 and Sabin-Reed (next to #6) is after the Botanic Gardens on the left hand side of the street.

The College Club (#25 on the map) is on the right hand side of College Lane, just past the Science Center.

Visitors may park anywhere on campus between white lines, that are not metered or otherwise marked. Parking lots are marked on the map, as well as the parking garage. Visitors need a parking pass 8am-5pm Monday-Friday.

From the North: From I-91 South, take Exit 20, and follow onto Route 5 south into the center of town. At the intersection of Route 5 and Route 9 (Main Street), turn right onto Route 9. Then follow the same directions as above from Route 9 to campus.

From the East or West via the Massachusetts Turnpike: Northampton is on Route I-91 North (Mass Pike exit 4). Once on I-91, follow the directions above for visitors from the south.
